



For those of you who work closely with those age 60 or older living in Champaign County:

Thanks to a Marajen Stevick Foundation Grant through the Community Foundation the Senior Resource Center at Family Service has funds available to address:

- unmet medical needs (medication, DMEs, dental, etc.)
 - unmet food (grocery) needs for seniors
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- Seniors may access each fund once in situations where other funds do not exist or are insufficient to meet the person's need.
 - Medical assistance will be paid directly to the provider/vendor by us.
 - Senior Resource Center staff will get a shopping list put together with the client, do the shopping, and deliver the food to the senior.
 - Referrals will be accepted from seniors or from professionals calling on their behalf. In either case, we will need to talk with the senior.
 - Call the Senior Resource Center at 352-5100 and asking to talk to someone about the "Stevick money."
 - For the one-time medical need we can assist with up to \$200.
 - For the one-time food need we can assist with up to \$100 per person.

(Even if the need for food or medicine is for less than the maximums, we can still only provide assistance to each person one time per fund.)
