A: Kids (12 years+) and **Adults** can get the vaccine

Q: What vaccines are available?

A: All clinics will have **Pfizer** and **Moderna** Vaccine --
1st and 2nd Doses
*Some clinics will have **Johnson&Johnson** Vaccine, when noted.*

Q: Do I need to make an Appointment?

A: No. All clinics are **walk in**.

Q: Do I need to bring an ID?

A: No. An ID is **not** required.
