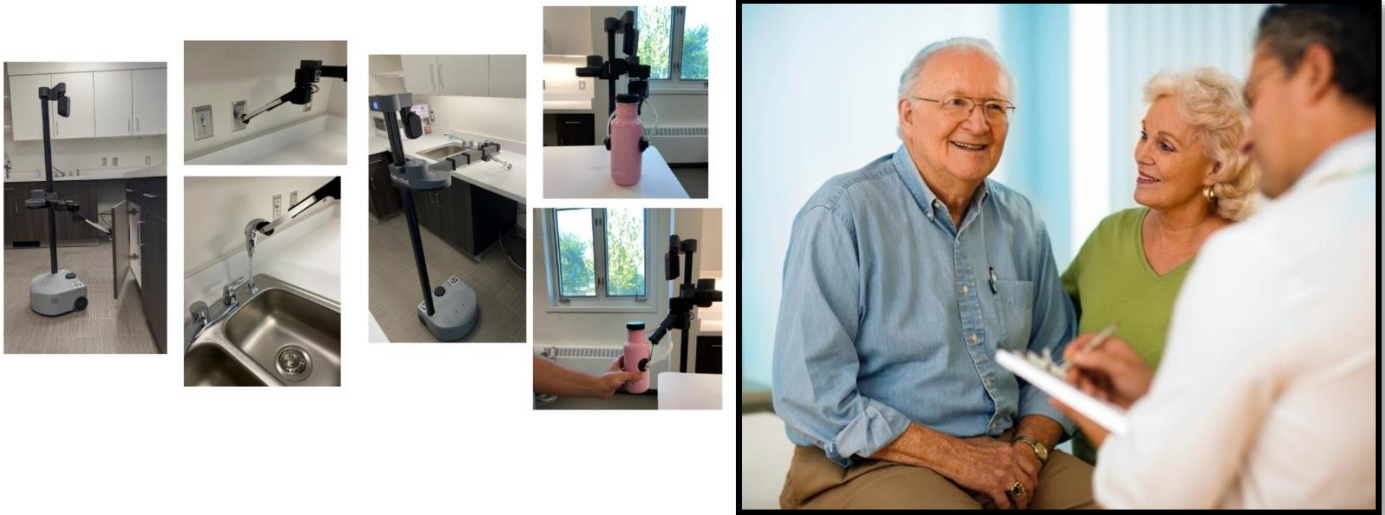


# Seeking Participants!

## Older Adults' Perceptions of the Stretch Robot

The College of Applied Health Sciences at the University of Illinois Urbana-Champaign is seeking research participants for an IRB-Approved research study (Approval # 22258).
